NOTICE

This is for information to all the students of Mangaldai Commerce College that as the Academic Session 2026-2027 has commenced and newly admitted students have joined the college, it has become necessary to reiterate that the Mangaldai Commerce College, Mangaldai, Darrang, Assam follows a Zero-Tolerance Policy towards Ragging. All students are hereby directed to strictly comply with the anti-ragging regulations and maintain a safe, respectful and inclusive campus environment.

It is hereby informed that ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the college campus, hostels, classrooms, common areas, sports facilities, transportation, online platforms or at any place connected with the college. Accordingly, all senior students are strictly directed not to:

- Call, summon or compel any fresher or junior student to visit hostel rooms or any other place for the purpose of introduction or interaction.
- Demand personal introductions or require any fresher to perform any act against their will.
- Subject any student to physical, verbal, mental, emotional or psychological harassment, intimidation or humiliation.
- Use abusive or offensive language or indulge in any behaviour that causes fear, embarrassment or discomfort.
- Share or circulate photographs, videos or personal information of freshers on social media or any other digital platform without their consent.
- Engage, directly or indirectly, in any act that constitutes ragging under the applicable laws and regulations.

It is further notified that any student found involved in ragging, directly or indirectly, shall be liable for stringent disciplinary action in accordance with the applicable laws, the University Regulations and the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. Such action may include, but shall not be limited to:

1. Suspension from the hostel and/or academic classes.
2. Debarment from attending classes, examinations, internships and college activities.
3. Withholding or cancellation of scholarships, fellowships or other academic privileges.
4. Rustication or expulsion from the college.
5. Entry of misconduct in the student's academic record.
6. Registration of an FIR with the Police and initiation of legal proceedings, wherever warranted.
7. Any other disciplinary action as may be deemed appropriate by the Competent Authority.

Students are advised to immediately report any incident of ragging or harassment to the Office of the Principal, the hostel Warden, the Faculties or any other competent college authority. The College shall ensure that every complaint is dealt with promptly, fairly and in accordance with the prescribed procedure.

All students are directed to adhere to the above instructions in letter and spirit and cooperate in maintaining a safe, secure, dignified and ragging-free campus for all.
